Online Learning for 5th, 6th, & 7th Graders

(May choose either online learning OR the traditional setting.)

*For summer school, students will be promoted to their 2019-20 grade levels. Current 6th graders/summer school 7th graders will remain at the elementary level for summer enrichment. Incoming Kindergartners will be eligible to attend a four-hour summer school day (8:15-12:15 or 9:15-1:15).



Before and After School Services will offer childcare during Summer Learning (Mon.-Thurs.) at each of the six locations from 6:30 am to school start and from dismissal to 6:00 pm. Full-day care will be provided on Fridays from 6:30 am - 6:00 pm. Children enrolling in Kids Country Before & After Care are required to enroll in Summer Learning. Children must enroll by the deadline below in order to participate in Kids Country during June.

Students, including incoming Kindergartners, have the opportunity to enroll for June and summer camp for the remainder of the summer.
